



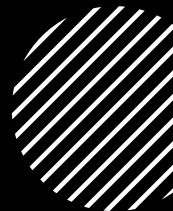



Reduce	Reduce violence against women and girls and sexually harmful behaviour
Look	Look after the wellbeing and diverse needs of the team
